

Dr. Jens Hellwage is managing director of the InfectoGnostics Research Campus in Jena, Germany, the Thuringian innovation cluster for diagnostics and biotechnology. The public-private partnership with more than 30 partners from science, medicine and industry develops infection diagnostics from concept to market-ready solutions for on-site analysis.

After studying biology in Hamburg, Jens Hellwage received his PhD from the Bernhard Nocht Institute for Tropical Medicine on the topic of regulators of the innate immune response and worked as a Postdoc at the Haartman Institute of the University of Helsinki (Finland). He then led the junior research group Molecular Immunobiology at the Leibniz Institute for Natural Product Research and Infection Biology in Jena. From 2005-2012 he worked for a startup company in the field of therapeutic antibodies, first as senior scientist and unit manager and then as project manager across sites in Jena and Basel. Since 2013 he has been working in the InfectoGnostics research campus, networking at the interface between academic research and the realization of diagnostic products in companies.
